The Scholarship: In January 2007, the Father Johns Scholarship was established as a tribute to St. John Vianney pastor, Fr. Tom Johns and as an attempt to assist students attending All Saints School with tuition costs. The All Saints Endowment Board will award annually three scholarships to current All Saints students. One student from each level (grades K-2; 3-5 and 6-8) will be awarded the scholarships.

Criteria: The recipients of the scholarships must be current students who exemplify one or more of the qualities modeled by Fr. Johns as defined below:

- Courage: a virtue of bravery in facing difficulties; especially in overcoming the consequences in doing good.
- Humility: a virtue that enables one to be marked by modesty or meekness; unpretentious.
- Gentleness: amiable; kind; tenderhearted.

The Process: Students may be nominated by an All Saints parent (other than the child's own parent); an All Saints teacher, a neighbor, or friend. The person nominating the child may not be a relative. The person nominating the child must submit in writing (2 paragraphs or less) the way the child exhibits or has the potential to exhibit the aforementioned qualities and how the nominator knows the child.

Nominations must be returned in an envelope to All Saints School or St. John Vianney Administration Center to the attention of Donna Regal by Friday, January 9, 2025.

The nomination forms will be reviewed by non-parent members of the All Saints Endowment Board.

Students selected as recipients of the scholarship will be announced at the Catholic Schools Week Mass at St. John Vianney on Saturday, January 24, 2025 at 6:00 pm.
